<b>Textiles</b>	A type of cloth or woven fabric
<b>Palette</b>	The range of colours used by a particular artist or in a particular picture
<b>Pattern</b>	A repeated decorative design
<b>Job</b>	A task or a piece of work, especially one that is paid
<b>Tapestry</b>	A piece of thick textile fabric with pictures or designs formed by weaving coloured weft threads or by embroidering on canvas, used as a wall hanging or soft furnishing.
